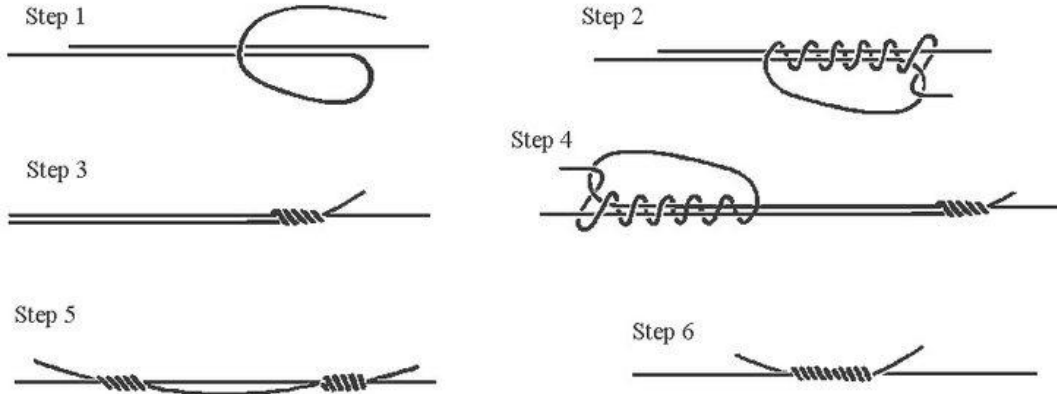

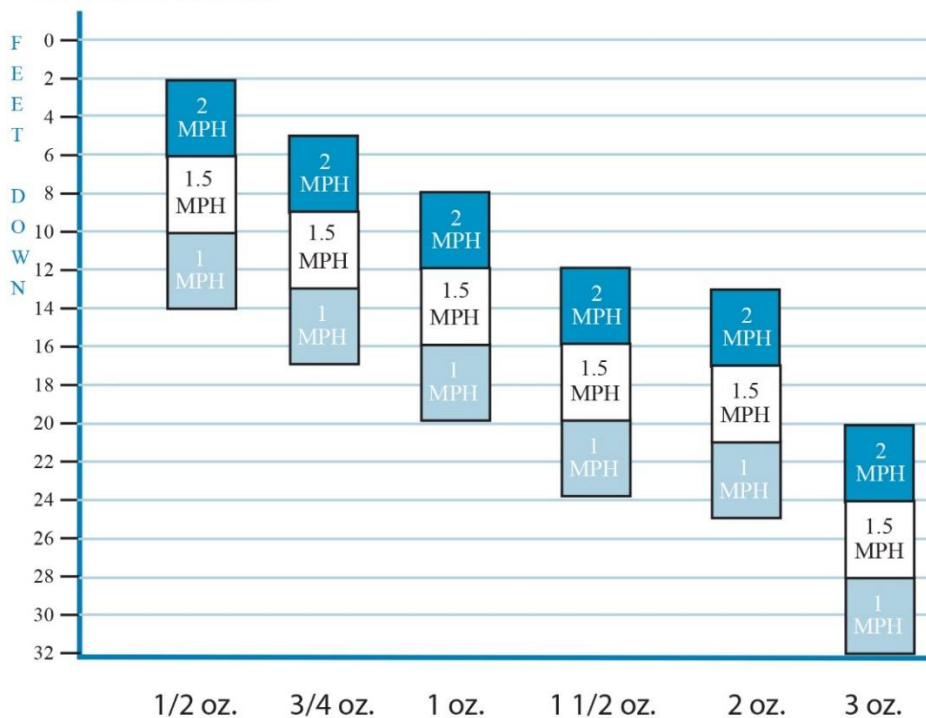
# 18LB LEADCORE LINE DIVE CURVE AT 1.8-2.2 MPH

## Pro Weight & Snap Weight Systems 50/50 Method



10lb mono: Depths shown are lure depths obtained by letting out a 50 ft leader, attaching the Weight, then letting out 50 ft of additional line.

Weight trolling is highly speed dependent! The depth bars shown represent the range of multiple measurements while maintaining the average speed indicated.

**How To Use:**  
Determine the desired target depth. Approximate trolling speed. Follow the reference line for that depth to find the best bar graph intersect for that speed. Choose the weight that corresponds to that depth range.
